


Chancerygate Foundation Bursary Programme



Who can apply?

You can apply for the Chancerygate Foundation Bursary if you meet the following criteria:

You are enrolled to study a RICS accredited course in one of the following:

- ✓ BSc Real Estate Management
- ✓ BSc Quantity Surveying
- ✓ BSc Building Surveying

You identify as being from black African or Caribbean heritage

Your household income is less than £25k per annum

You will be under the age of 26 when you start the course

You must also meet one of the following criteria:

- ✓ You are the first generation in your family to progress to higher education (i.e. your parents have not been to university although if a brother or sister has, you are still eligible)
- ✓ You identify yourself as being disabled or having a specific learning difference
- ✓ You have spent time in care in the UK, been placed in care or are estranged from your family
- ✓ You are recognised by social services as a young adult carer
- ✓ You are entering Higher Education with a BTEC as your main qualification
- ✓ You are a mature student (aged 21 years or over on 1 September before you start your course) who does not currently hold a bachelor's degree

What information do I need to submit?

All the following supporting information must be included as part of your application. Incomplete applications (those missing any of the required information below) will not be processed.

Personal Statement (maximum 500 words)

- ✓ Your academic strength and achievements, prizes and awards, work and volunteering experience
- ✓ Why you want to take this course
- ✓ What you hope to go on to do when you complete your course
- ✓ Why you deserve financial support and what you intend to do with the financial support you receive.

Shortlisted applicants will also be expected to attend a short interview with the Chancerygate Foundation in September prior to the award being given.

Photocopy of your passport.

Please supply financial statements and supporting financial documentation as part of your application.
